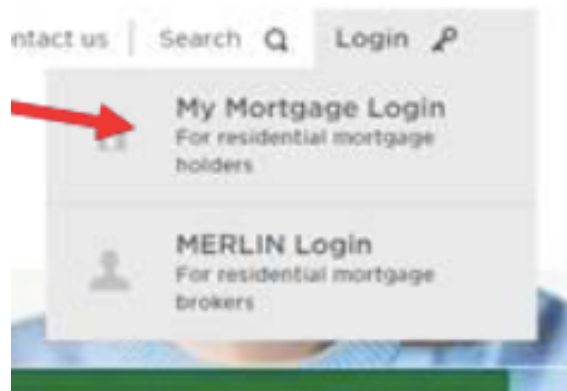



First National Online Set-up

Step 1 — Go to www.firstnational.ca

Step 2 — You will see the Login at the top right. Click and the drop-down will show below. Click on the My Mortgage Login
